Your transfer station is for disposal of household refuse. No concrete, medical waste, dirt, leaves, grass clippings, liquids, pesticides, or other hazardous material are accepted.

There is also a **recycling bin**, single stream recycling, enables you to mix all of your CLEAN plastic jugs, metal cans, glass bottles, and paper products together in one container.....no need to separate. Ask the attendant for an information sheet. You must present a Merrill Township Transfer Station I.D. Card when you use the Transfer Station.
